

DROP-IN GUTTER GUARDS

Keeps Leaves and Debris Out of Gutters



- Drops into place quickly and easily.
- Reinforced edge adds rigidity and strength.
- Fits both 5" and 6" K-style gutters.
- Handy 3-foot sections.
- 50 pieces per box.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR DROP-IN GUTTER GUARD

- 1) Starting at one end, slightly lift the shingles and slide the back edge of the gutter guard under the shingles. Next, push the front edge against the lip of the gutter. Repeat this process with the next piece of gutter guard, avoiding gaps and overlaps.
- 2) When you get to the end of the gutter, you may have to shorten the length of the gutter guard. If so, simply cut off the excess material.
- 3) For outside corners, cut a 45-degree angle off the opposite ends of two adjoining pieces. Slide under the shingles and push onto the gutter to form an accurate corner joint.
- 4) For inside corners, you must allow for the splashguards. Make a $\frac{3}{4}$ " cut out of the gutter guard to clear the splashguard. Next cut a 45-degree angle off the opposite ends of two adjoining pieces. Slide the guard under the shingles and push onto the gutter to form an accurate corner joint.
